

The Woodridge community has long considered the District 99 property adjacent to Town Centre to be the single most important location for open space, recreation, and civic uses in the Village. The action taken last week by District 99 to sell the property for **high intensity residential** use was a shocking disappointment!

Village, Park District, and District 99 officials have participated in two meetings since the intent to sell was announced. Those meetings have *not resulted in the commitment to sell the property for its intended use.*

The Village of Woodridge and the Woodridge Park District will take the appropriate steps to protect the use of the property for the Woodridge community. High density multi-family use is not the answer.

At the April 21, 2005 Board Meeting the Village Board will consider an ordinance to authorize negotiations to acquire the property.
