

## ***District 99 Reneges on 30+ Year Commitment!***

Community High School District 99 announced Tuesday that they will sell the 44-acre property they own in Woodridge adjacent to Town Centre. The Village of Woodridge, along with the Woodridge Park District, absolutely agrees that this property should be sold.

We are disappointed that District 99 is reneging on the commitments it has made and reaffirmed consistently for over 30 years that the property would always be used for public purposes and that, if it was not needed for a high school, the property would be sold to the Village of Woodridge.

Our community has built its plans around the expectation that District 99 could be trusted to stick to its commitments for the use of the property; we've built a Town Centre around the expectation that property would be used for community purposes and our residents have built and purchased homes around that expectation.

Now District 99 says it is abandoning these decade-old commitments and will build a multi-family development on this valuable community gathering place.
