I have some "scoop" regarding the proposed junk yard next to Greene Valley Forest Preserve.

First, the proposal was NEVER to put this thing on forest preserve property. I've received several emails stating this. The proposal puts it on county-owned property next to the county's sewage treatment plant along the East Branch of the DuPage River that is across the river and next to forest preserve property.

Second, it was proposed by the Sheriff.

Now, I just had a long conversation with Tom Bennington, County Board member from District 3, and I expressed some concerns to him. He said that although he wanted to first gather all the facts, he and others have been working to kill the project at that location.

I also talked to Schillerstrom and I feel confident that this is dead.
