Thank you for your letter regarding the proposed recycling facility and existing permitted landscape waste transfer station in Bolingbrook, Illinois.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) is responsible for administering permits and regulating the operations of solid waste processing facilities. While the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has not developed regulations for solid waste transfer facilities and does not permit these facilities, there is general information regarding transfer stations and their place in an integrated waste management system on our web site: <http://www.epa.gov/epaoswer/non-hw/transfer.htm>. This information may be of interest to you.

My staff contacted Illinois EPA regarding your concerns. Violations have been found, and Will County is currently proceeding through the enforcement process of this facility.
