According to Mr. Rizzi a number of factors influenced his decision. They included the Village of Woodridges' overzealous pursuit of traffic issues and weight limitation and the amount of erroneous and misleading information that has been distributed. It is the Village's understanding that they have no immediate plan to refile. They are not asking for any Village action so there will be no further public hearings or public meetings concerning the property.

We have been informed that the current business of recycling construction and demolition materials will be altered to conform with Will County (IEPA) rules. We believe the materials will be pre-sorted offsite before delivery. The other two operations; the permitted transfer of landscape material and topsoil storage will continue on the site.
