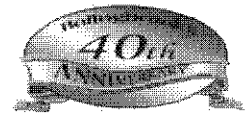

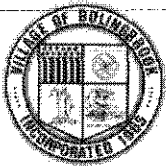

The Village has heard a lot of misinformation about this project. The following are accurate facts about the facility:

- Steve Tamling began storing construction materials and topsoil on the site in 1985.
- Woodridge annexed the properties east of this site in 1989 and zoned them residential.
- Steve Tamling annexed the subject property to the Village of Bolingbrook in 1991 and zoned it I-1 (Limited Industrial) to accommodate the existing uses.
- Steve Tamling and now E.C. Rizzi have three operations being conducted on the site:
  1. Storage of topsoil.
  2. A transfer station for landscape material only. In accordance with state legislation an IEPA permit was required in 1997 which was obtained.
  3. A construction material and demolition debris recycling center.
- Solid Waste is divided into two categories by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. Landscape Waste and Construction and Demolition Debris are labeled "non special waste".
- This facility is **not** a:
  1. compost facility
  2. landfill
  3. medical waste facility
  4. garbage transfer station or a
  5. hazardous disposal facility.
