Dear Mr. Brandt:


I am in receipt of your letter (attached) dated November 17, 2002, regarding a concern from a resident at Vail Lane. On November 22, 2002, I met with the resident along with Superintendent of Operations Tony Fowler and Crew Chief Ben Santore.

Mr. Santore had previously met with the resident and advised that Public Works would, indeed, be replacing a section of curb adjacent to his home. Mr. Santore further advised the resident that it was possible that we may complete this work yet this season, but if not, the work would be done in the Spring when the weather is more conducive to this type of work.

During our meeting with the resident on November 22, Mr. Fowler and I agreed with Mr. Santore's assessment that the current condition of the curb line will not present any serious drainage issues over the winter and that it should be put on a list of other concrete work. It is typical for our department to assemble a list of concrete work (that doesn't present a safety hazard or drainage problem) and have it all done at one time, in order to make better use of our resources.

My impression at the end of meeting was that the resident was satisfied with our response. I gave him my business card in case he had any further concerns or questions and invited him to contact me at any time.
