Dear Mr. Brandt:

I am in receipt of your letter (attached) dated November 17, 2002, regarding construction traffic, dirt and mud on Hillcrest. On November 22, 2002, I toured this area and then met with Village Engineer Zill Khan and Engineering Inspector Roy Martinez

We agreed that the dirt and mud on the streets from construction traffic was beyond what we should tolerate. While we had instructed Gallagher & Henry to clean the streets twice per week, it is apparent that it requires a higher level of attention to keep up with all the construction activity.

Mr. Martinez, who is inspecting the public improvements related to this project, and Mr. Kelly Fessler, the Building Inspector overseeing the private construction, have advised Gallagher & Henry that the streets must be kept clean, even if this requires daily scraping and sweeping. Both of these inspectors have been instructed to routinely assess the condition of the streets and to strictly hold the developer to our expectations.

Since you did not forward the name of the resident who you spoke with, I would appreciate if you would forward the contact information to me so that I may respond directly and invite this resident to keep in contact with me regarding this matter.
